Award Criteria

The DAYL Outstanding Mentor Award is awarded to a lawyer in Dallas who has consistently demonstrated a commitment to mentoring young lawyers in his or her legal community. Nominees must be licensed to practice law in Texas, be fully paid up regarding any membership dues prescribed by the Supreme Court of Texas, and be members in good standing of the State Bar. The Awards Committee will consider all outstanding qualities of a nominee, including (1) the nominee's service as a role model to young lawyers in the legal community; (2) the nominee's efforts to foster the development of young lawyers; and (3) the nominee's significant contributions to the profession and/or the community. Lawyers of any age, who also meet the above criteria, are eligible to receive this award.

Nominations must be received no later than 5:00 p.m., Monday, March 9, 2020. Submit the application and any supporting materials to Cherie Harris (cherieh@dayl.com).
