**Award Criteria**

The DAYL Outstanding Young Lawyer Award is awarded to a Dallas young lawyer who is 36 years of age or younger as of June 1, 2020 or licensed to practice law for five (5) years or less as of the same date. Nominees must be licensed to practice law in Texas and be members in good standing of the State Bar. The Awards Committee will consider all outstanding qualities of a nominee, including (i) professional excellence, (ii) service to the profession and the bar, (iii) service to the community, and/or (iv) a reputation for or the advancement of legal ethics and professional responsibility.

Current officers and directors of the Texas Young Lawyers Association, and members of the TYLA Outstanding Young Lawyer of Texas Awards Committee, are not eligible to receive this award.
