APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Please complete the attached application for the DAYL Foundation Alexander Bolton Law Student Scholarship. One \$2,500.00 scholarship will be awarded to a UNT Dallas College of Law class of 2024, 2025, or 2026 student (rising 2L, 3L or 4L) who has completed at least 20 hours of UNT Dallas College of Law's required public service hours, and who has displayed an appreciation of and commitment to the importance of giving back to the community and improving access to legal justice.

In addition to verifying an applicant's service in the community engagement program, the selection committee panel will consider an applicant's competency, character, law school and community involvement, leadership, and general performance in law school. Applicants are required to submit **(i)** this application, **(ii)** a one-page résumé, **(iii)** two (2) letters of recommendation, **(iv)** certification of community engagement service hours from the UNT Dallas College of Law's Director of Experiential Education, and **(v)** a current transcript. Feel free to attach your answers to the questions below on separate sheets.

Applications must be **received by September 29, 2023**. Please return your completed application to Sherolyn Hurst, J.D. – Assistant Dean for Admissions and Scholarships, Sherolyn.hurst@untdallas.edu, 214.752.5981. If necessary, the DAYL Foundation will interview candidates.

The recipient of the Alexander Bolton Law Student Scholarship will be notified in early November and recognized at the DAYL Foundation Award of Excellence Luncheon, currently scheduled for 11:30 a.m.-1:00 p.m., December 7, 2023. The scholarship recipient will receive an invitation to the Luncheon and must attend unless otherwise excused by the DAYL Foundation and UNT Dallas College of Law's Admissions Operations and Program Coordinator. The scholarship shall be given directly to UNT Dallas College of Law by the end of the year and shall be applied to the scholarship recipient's Spring 2024 tuition and fees.

The Scholarship is named in memory of Alexander Wade Bolton, a zealous advocate of the DAYL and the DAYL Foundation. Alex began his service in DAYL as a co-chair of the DAYL Law Student Assistance Committee. He was selected to the 2013 DAYL Leadership Class, which organized the DAYL Charity Ball as their class project. In 2016, Alex successfully sought to change the beneficiary of the DAYL Charity Ball to the DAYL Foundation where it is now the largest fund-raising event of the Foundation. Alex served as Secretary of the DAYL and was elected to serve as Treasurer two days before his untimely death on October 21, 2017, which was as a result of a motor vehicle accident. In December 2017, the Board of Trustees of the DAYL Foundation voted unanimously to rename the DAYL Foundation Scholarships in his memory.
