2023 Nomination Form
Nomination Deadline May 19, 2023**

The DAYL's Young Lawyer Pro Bono Service Award was created in 2011 to recognize the public service or legal aid performed by an individual young lawyer who in the preceding year has provided outstanding contributions and access to justice to those in need of legal services.

Eligibility: The DAYL Young Lawyer Pro Bono Service Award is awarded to a Dallas young lawyer who has been licensed to practice for 12 years or less as of January 1st of the year for which the award is sought. Nominees must be licensed to practice law in Texas and be members in good standing of the State Bar of Texas and the Dallas Association of Young Lawyers. The DAYL Equal Access to Justice Committee will consider all outstanding qualities of a nominee, including the breadth and impact of the nominee's work and evidence of the nominee's continuing commitment to pro bono work.

Nominees must have performed their pro bono work with no expectation of being paid by the client or receiving attorneys' fees (unless agreed upon in advance that those fees would be donated to charity).

Deadline for Applications: Nominations must be received by no later than **Friday, May 19, 2023**. Submit the nomination form and any additional supporting materials to:
